Case Examples

- 64-year-old woman sustained significant orthopaedic injuries, issues with wound healing including infection of skin graft area and donor site. Prolonged hospital admission, facilitation of private inpatient rehabilitation and complex discharge planning and transfer of care to private providers within her local community.
- 32-year-old man sustained compound fracture of ankle (near traumatic amputation) with severe soft tissue damage and significant degloving injury to lower leg, which required external fixation and later surgical fixation of ankle joint. Return to leisure activities including cycling with electric bicycle and employment including consulting and voluntary positions.
