Case Examples

- 23-year-old female. Traumatic brain injury following road traffic accident. Facilitation of rehabilitation in home environment to support development of independent living skills and strategies to support progressing to independent living in the future. Develop and review Personal Assistant (PA) support plans ensuring client central to planning and implementation. Support recruitment of PA's to provide skilled level of support. Support with finances.
- 50-year-old male with complex multiple trauma injuries following road traffic accident (motorbike vs car). Facilitation of private inpatient rehabilitation and complex discharge planning requiring change in accommodation. Co-ordination of MDT, therapy intervention, medical appointments, and additional services on return to the community. Client motivated to return to driving and work. Completed risk assessments with MDT following changes in presentation to mitigate risks whilst maximising independence and quality of life.
