Case Examples

This included private physiotherapy for physical recovery and psychological therapy to address trauma, anxiety, and reduced confidence. Louise's supportive and empathetic approach helped the client feel safe, informed, and listened to. The early legal settlement provided space to focus on recovery and enabled a return to meaningful activities, holidays, and a more hopeful outlook for retirement.
