Case Management Competencies

Case Examples

30 year old male involved in a motorbike accident; bilateral upper limb orthopaedic injuries who was motivated to return to riding his motorbike, playing guitar and maintaining his employment.

21 year old female involved in a polytrauma, with lower limb amputation, internal injuries, complex wound injuries and psychological trauma. Prolonged hospital admission, facilitation of private inpatient rehabilitation and complex discharge planning requiring change in accommodation.

57 year old male self employed joiner involved in motorbike vs car accident; complex orthopaedic lower limb issues, including osteomyelitis, limb salvage and psychological issues – keen to return to pre injury role.
